

## Hoist track – instructions for construction of hoist beam

Information within brackets ([...]) in this document refers to local regulations.

### Scope

This standard provides instructions on the construction of a hoist beam. Its purpose is to assist clients with producing correct ordering data at an early stage, and to assist designers with acquiring information on dimensioning criteria.

The standard does not include hoist track suspension. Each suspension operation must be dimensioned separately.

### Changes since the previous edition

This edition mainly differs from the previous one in that:

- Welding symbols have been removed in all figures.
- Chapter 5.2 – "Labelling" has been updated with new information.
- References have been updated and reference to [AFS 2006:6] has been added.
- The appearance of the standard has been updated to the current template for SSG standards.
